That which has been joined together in spirit cannot be put asunder by those on earth nor can earth bind by wedlock two hearts, which are divinely free.

For this cause was man and woman created as such; to love one another, and to join together with god in the creation of new life.

Minister to Groom: Please repeat after me: In the Spirit of love and unity, I,, marry you,, merging my life and its purpose with yours and shall endeavor to love and honor you as I do my true self.
Minister to Bride: Please repeat after me:
In the Spirit of love and unity, I,, marry you,, merging my life and its purpose with yours and shall endeavor to love and honor you as I do my true self.
Ring ceremony:
What token do you give in love?
(wedding ring is passed to minister) (Minister holds the ring up, saying to the audience)

(Minister hands ring to bride and bride places ring on third finger of left hand of groom)

(Minister to groom: Repeat after me.)
As a token of our devotion, I give it place upon my hand.
(same process to groom if double ring ceremony)
